

Spring Cleaning Isn't Just About Decluttering



Here's What Else to **Check** Around Your Home



Air Conditioning & Cooling Systems

- Replace or clean air filters to improve airflow and efficiency
- Make sure vents are open and unobstructed by furniture or rugs
- Listen for unusual noises when the system runs
- Notice whether some rooms feel warmer than others



Plumbing & Water Systems

- Look under sinks for moisture, drips, or water stains
- Check around toilets and washing machines for signs of leaks
- Notice slow drains or changes in water pressure
- Pay attention to water discoloration or unusual odors



Electrical Systems

- Test outlets and switches for warmth, flickering, or buzzing
- Make sure extension cords aren't being used as permanent solutions
- Check outdoor outlets and lighting for visible wear
- Confirm GFCI outlets work properly in kitchens, bathrooms, and outdoors



Solar & Energy Systems

- Visually inspect panels for dirt buildup or debris
- Ensure nothing is blocking sunlight, such as new tree growth
- Review energy bills for unexpected changes



Insulation & Home Comfort

- Peek into attics or garages for visible insulation gaps
- Feel for drafts near doors and windows
- Check weather stripping and seals



Air & Water Quality

- Replace HVAC filters regularly
- Pay attention to lingering odors or increased dust
- Notice changes in water taste or clarity



General Home Safety

- Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Replace batteries as needed
- Review fire extinguishers for accessibility and expiration
- Ensure outdoor pathways and lighting are safe and clear
